- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the governing body of a county or Baltimore City to establish 5 a certain community advisory committee for student assignment within a certain 6 time period after the county board of education votes to begin a school redistricting 7 process; establishing the purpose of a community advisory committee; providing for the composition, chair, and meetings of a community advisory committee; 8 9 prohibiting a member of a community advisory committee from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring a 10 11 community advisory committee to review and provide input on certain redistricting 12 proposals; providing for the termination of a community advisory committee; and generally relating to the public school redistricting process. 13

- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 4 $\,$ 1, 2020.
