1 AN ACT concerning

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Economic Development – Makerspace Initiative Pilot Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Makerspace Initiative Pilot Program in the Maryland 4 Technology Development Corporation; establishing the purposes of the Program; $\mathbf{5}$ requiring the Corporation to partner with a certain entity to provide technical 6 assistance to certain nonprofit entities; authorizing the Corporation to award certain 7 financial assistance to local governments, certain designees of local governments, 8 and certain nonprofit entities for the establishment of makerspaces in the State; requiring the Corporation, after consulting with the Secretary of Commerce, to adopt 9 10 certain standards; authorizing the Corporation to award financial assistance subject 11 to certain limitations; requiring a recipient of financial assistance to provide certain matching funds or in-kind contributions; prohibiting the Corporation from awarding 12 13financial assistance within a single county exceeding a certain amount except under 14 certain circumstances; establishing the Makerspace Initiative Fund as a special, 15nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Executive Director of the Maryland Technology Development Corporation or the Executive 1617Director's designee to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the 18 Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying the contents of the 19Fund; requiring the Governor, for certain fiscal years, to include a certain 20appropriation in the annual budget bill for the Fund; providing for the investment of 21money in and expenditures from the Fund; requiring interest earnings of the Fund 22to be credited to the Fund; providing that certain appropriations and expenditures 23are subject to audit by the Office of Legislative Audits; exempting the Fund from a 24certain provision of law requiring interest earnings on State money to accrue to the

2 (A) AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE SECRETARY, THE CORPORATION SHALL 3 ADOPT STANDARDS TO AWARD FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

- 4 (B) THE CORPORATION MAY AWARD FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO:
- 5 (1) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT;

6 (2) AN AGENCY, AN INSTRUMENTALITY, OR A NONPROFIT 7 CORPORATION THAT THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DESIGNATES; OR

8 (3) A NONPROFIT ENTITY OPERATING OR SEEKING TO OPERATE A 9 MAKERSPACE IN THE STATE.

14(2)\$250,000 TO ESTABLISH OR EXPAND MAKERSPACES IN UP TO15FOUR COUNTIES NOT SERVED BY WESTERN MARYLAND WORKS.

16 (D) A RECIPIENT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL 17 PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS OR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE PROJECT AT 18 LEAST EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AWARDED.

25 (B) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 26 SUBJECT TO REVERSION UNDER § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND 27 PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

28 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 29 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2020. It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of September 21 30, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be 22 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
