A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Workgroup on Establishing a Science and Technology Best Practices and 3 **Innovation Network** 4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Workgroup on Establishing a Science and Technology 5 Best Practices and Innovation Network; providing for the composition, chair, and 6 staffing of the Workgroup; prohibiting a member of the Workgroup from receiving 7 certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; 8 requiring the Workgroup to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Workgroup to report its findings and recommendations to the 9 Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the 10 11 termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Workgroup on Establishing a 12 Science and Technology Best Practices and Innovation Network. SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That: 14 There is a Workgroup on Establishing a Science and Technology Best 15 (a) 16 Practices and Innovation Network. 17 (b) The Workgroup consists of the following members: 18 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 19 the Senate: 20 (2) one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the 21 House: 22 (3) the Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary's designee; 23 (4) the Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary's designee;

- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2021, this
- 5 Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no
- 6 further force and effect.
