- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 23 (g) (1) "Extraordinary medical expenses" means uninsured costs for medical



- treatment in excess of \$250 PAID CUMULATIVELY BY BOTH PARENTS in any calendar year.
- 3 (2) "Extraordinary medical expenses" includes uninsured, reasonable, and 4 necessary costs for orthodontia, dental treatment, vision care, asthma treatment, physical 5 therapy, treatment for any chronic health problem, and professional counseling or 6 psychiatric therapy for diagnosed mental disorders.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2020.
