BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments. Article – Election Law Section 9–310 Annotated Code of Maryland (2017 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article – Election Law 9-310.
