FOR the purpose of establishing that modifying a certain exception to the prohibition 4 against placing the erection or maintenance of outdoor signs along or near $\mathbf{5}$ 6 expressways for signs that are placed in accordance with certain local zoning laws and ordinances applies to off-premises signs; making certain conforming and 7 stylistic changes; elarifying certain language; and generally relating to exceptions to 8 9 the prohibition against placing certain the placement of outdoor signs along expressways.
