- FOR the purpose of requiring the council of unit owners or other governing body of a 4 condominium association to submit the adopted annual budget to the unit owners by $\mathbf{5}$ 6 a certain day; authorizing the adopted annual budget to be submitted to each unit 7 owner by certain methods; requiring the board of directors or other governing body 8 of a homeowners association to submit the adopted annual budget to the lot owners 9 by a certain day; authorizing the adopted annual budget to be sent submitted to each 10 lot owner by certain methods; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to 11 the adopted annual budget of a homeowners association.

4 (a) This section applies only to a homeowners association that has responsibility 5 under its declaration for maintaining and repairing common areas.

6 (b) (1) The board of directors or other governing body of a homeowners 7 association shall cause to be prepared and submitted to the lot owners an annual proposed 8 budget at least 30 days before its adoption.

9 (2) The annual proposed budget may be sent to each lot owner by electronic 10 transmission, by posting on the homeowners association's home page, or by including the 11 annual proposed budget in the homeowners association's newsletter.

12 (c) The annual budget shall provide information on or expenditures for at least 13 the following items:

- 14 (1) Income;
- 15 (2) Administration;
- 16 (3) Maintenance;
- 17 (4) Utilities;
- 18 (5) General expenses;
- 19 (6) Reserves; and
- 20 (7) Capital expenses.

(d) (1) The budget shall be adopted at an open meeting of the homeowners
 association or any other body to which the homeowners association delegates
 responsibilities for preparing and adopting the budget.

(2) (1) THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OR OTHER GOVERNING BODY OF
 A HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION SHALL SUBMIT THE ADOPTED ANNUAL BUDGET TO
 THE LOT OWNERS NOT MORE THAN 30 DAYS AFTER THE MEETING AT WHICH THE
 BUDGET WAS ADOPTED.

(II) THE ADOPTED ANNUAL BUDGET MAY BE SENT SUBMITTED
 TO EACH LOT OWNER BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION, BY POSTING ON THE

1 [(2)] (3) (i) Notice of the meeting at which the proposed budget will be 2 considered shall be sent to each lot owner.

3 (ii) Notice under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph may be sent by 4 electronic transmission, by posting on the homeowners association's home page, or by 5 including the notice in the homeowners association's newsletter.

6 (e) Except for an expenditure made by the homeowners association because of a 7 condition that, if not corrected, could reasonably result in a threat to the health or safety 8 of the lot owners or a significant risk of damage to the development, any expenditure that 9 would result in an increase in an amount of assessments for the current fiscal year of the 10 homeowners association in excess of 15% of the budgeted amount previously adopted shall 11 be approved by an amendment to the budget adopted at a special meeting for which not 12 less than 10 days' written notice shall be provided to the lot owners.

13 (f) The adoption of a budget does not impair the authority of the homeowners 14 association to obligate the homeowners association for expenditures for any purpose 15 consistent with any provision of this title.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2020.
