3 FOR the purpose of establishing a club public event permit in the City of Annapolis; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for the City of Annapolis to issue 4 the permit to a holder of a Class C license; specifying that the permit authorizes a $\mathbf{5}$ 6 club to sell certain alcoholic beverages to an individual who is not a member or a 7 guest of a member for on-premises consumption during a certain public event; 8 requiring a permit holder to submit an application for approval to the Board at least 9 a certain number of days before a public event; authorizing the Board to approve up 10 to a certain number of public events per permit holder in a calendar year; and 11 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in the City of Annapolis.
