Public Service Commission – Application for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity – Preservation of Environmental Quality and the Climate

FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission to give due consideration to
the effect of a generating station, overhead transmission line, or qualified generator
lead line on the preservation of environmental quality and the climate before taking
final action on an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity;
and generally relating to an application for a certificate of public convenience and
necessity.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 (e) The Commission shall take final action on an application for a certificate of 20 public convenience and necessity only after due consideration of:

(1) the recommendation of the governing body of each county or municipal
 corporation in which any portion of the construction of the generating station, overhead
 transmission line, or qualified generator lead line is proposed to be located;
