- 24 (5) NOTICE REQUIREMENTS TO APPROPRIATE SCHOOL PERSONNEL,
- 25 PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OR CAREGIVERS, AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT, IF
- 26 NECESSARY; AND
- 27 (6) Any other issues concerning the administration of
- 28 MEDICAL CANNABIS TO STUDENTS WHO ARE QUALIFYING PATIENTS DURING

- 1 SCHOOL HOURS AND SCHOOL-SPONSORED AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES.
- 2 (C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2020, THE DEPARTMENT AND THE 3 NATALIE M. LAPRADE MEDICAL CANNABIS COMMISSION JOINTLY SHALL:
- 4 (1) PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO SCHOOLS TO:
- 5 (I) IMPLEMENT THE GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS
- 6 SECTION; AND
- 7 (II) INSTRUCT SCHOOL PERSONNEL AT THE LOCAL LEVEL
- 8 REGARDING THE GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- 9 **(2) D**EVELOP A PROCESS TO MONITOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 10 GUIDELINES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
