A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Election Law - County Central Committees - Democratic Party Requirements

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law concerning the composition of 4 Democratic Party Central Committees in certain counties; requiring the members of 5 each county Democratic Party Central Committee to be elected in accordance with 6 certain rules and bylaws; requiring that the method of election of members of each 7 county Democratic Party Central Committee promote geographic balance to the 8 extent practicable; requiring the Democratic State Central Committee to notify the 9 State Board of Elections of the number of elected members for each county Democratic Party Central Committee and the composition of the districts of the 10 11 elected members of each county Democratic Party Central Committee not later than 12 a certain amount of time before a certain deadline; authorizing a change affecting 13 the method of election of county Democratic Party Central Committee members to 14 take effect only after certain actions have been taken; prohibiting a change to the 15 method of election of county Democratic Party Central Committee members from 16 occurring during an election cycle if the Democratic State Central Committee has 17 made a certain notification; and generally relating to Democratic Party Central 18 Committees.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 25 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 1 (a) In Anne Arundel County, the members of the [Democratic and] Republican 2 Party Central [Committees] **COMMITTEE** for the county shall be elected as follows: 3 three members shall be elected from each legislative district wholly 4 contained within Anne Arundel County; and 5 (2)one member shall be elected from that portion within Anne Arundel 6 County of any legislative district that is partially contained within Anne Arundel County. 7 (b) (1)(i) In Baltimore City, the Democratic Party Central Committee 8 consists of seven members elected from each of the six legislative districts of Baltimore 9 City. 10 Each member shall reside in, and be elected by the voters of, the (ii) 11 legislative district that the member represents. 12 (2)The IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE members of the Republican (i) 13 Party Central Committee shall be elected from each councilmanic district of Baltimore City. 14 [(ii)] **(2)** Two members shall be elected from each councilmanic district. 15 16 [(iii)] **(3)** An individual appointed to fill a vacancy of a member of 17 the Republican Party Central Committee may reside anywhere in Baltimore City. [(1)] In Baltimore County, the Republican Party Central Committee shall 18 consist of four members elected from each councilmanic district in the county. 19 20(2)For the Baltimore County Democratic Party Central Committee: 2120 members, five from each district, shall be elected from 22legislative districts 6, 8, 10, and 11, each district being located wholly within Baltimore 23County; 24four members shall be elected from legislative district 44B that (ii) 25 is located wholly in Baltimore County; 26 four members shall be elected from that part of legislative 27 district 7 that is located in Baltimore County; 28 four members shall be elected from that part of legislative
- 30 (v) five members, of which two members shall be from delegate 31 district 42A and three members shall be from delegate district 42B, shall be elected from

district 12 that is located in Baltimore County; and

- legislative district 42 that is located wholly in Baltimore County. 1
- 2 Only individuals affiliated with the Democratic Party and who are 3 registered to vote in Baltimore County may vote for the election of members to the 4
 - Baltimore County Democratic Party Central Committee under this section.
- 5 The number of Democratic Party Central Committee members to be 6 elected from each legislative district, or portion of legislative district, in Baltimore County 7 shall be determined upon completion of each legislative districting.
- 8 (d) In Calvert County, the Democratic Party Central Committee consists of nine members elected by the voters of the county at large as follows: 9
- 10 two members who reside in the first election district and receive the (1) largest number of votes cast for candidates from that district; 11
- 12 (2)two members who reside in the second election district and receive the 13 largest number of votes cast for candidates from that district:
- 14 two members who reside in the third election district and receive the largest number of votes cast for candidates from that district; and 15
- 16 three members who reside in Calvert County and who receive the 17 highest number of votes cast in Calvert County for the remaining candidates.
- 18 In Carroll County, the Republican Party Central Committee shall consist of nine members elected at large. 19
- 20(f) (1) In Montgomery County, for the Democratic Party Central Committee:
- 21two members are elected from each of the legislative districts (i) 22that lie wholly within Montgomery County;
- 23(ii) one member is elected from the Montgomery County part of each 24legislative district that is partially within Montgomery County; and
- members shall be elected at large equal to the number of 25 26 legislative districts that lie wholly within Montgomery County, except that not more than 27 two members at large may reside in the same legislative district.
- 28 (2)Any vacancy in a seat on the Democratic Party Central Committee held 29 initially by a member elected from a legislative district shall be filled by a person residing 30 in that district.
- Any reference to the Democratic Party Central Committee for 31 32 Montgomery County or any portion of it means the entire membership of the Montgomery
- 33 County Democratic Party Central Committee, and in no event do the members of the

- 1 Central Committee elected from a district comprise a separate central committee. 2 (g)] **(E)** (1) [(i)]In Prince George's County, members of the Republican 3 Party Central Committee: [1.] (I) may run at large to fill historically vacant seats; and 4 [2.] (II) 5 unless a member runs at large under item 1 of this subparagraph, shall be elected from within legislative districts of Prince George's County 6 7 or within that portion of any legislative district lying within Prince George's County. 8 The number of members of the Republican Party Central (ii) (2) 9 Committee shall, to the extent practicable, consist of two members from each of the eight 10 legislative districts lying within Prince George's County. 11 (2)In Prince George's County, the Democratic Party Central (i) Committee consists of 24 members. 12 13 (ii) Two members shall reside in and be elected by the eligible 14 voters of each of the eight legislative districts lying within Prince George's County. 2. 15 At least one member shall reside in each single-member or two-member delegate district of any district in which there are such districts. 16 17 In addition to the members of the committee elected from (iii) 18 legislative districts, eight members of the committee shall be elected by all the eligible 19 voters in the county, and at the time of election, each member shall reside in a different one 20 of the eight legislative districts within Prince George's County. 21A candidate for election to the Democratic Party Central 22Committee shall declare at the time of filing for candidacy which seat on the Central 23 Committee the candidate is seeking. 24If a member who was elected from a specific legislative district 25ceases to reside in that district, the member may not continue to serve on the Central 26 Committee. 27 In Worcester County, the Democratic Party Central Committee consists (h) (1)of 11 members as follows: 2829 (i) seven members who shall reside in and be elected, respectively, 30 by the eligible voters of each of the seven county commissioner districts; and
- 31 (ii) four members who shall reside in Worcester County, be elected 32 at large by the eligible voters of the entire county, and receive the highest number of votes 33 cast for candidates in the at large election.

- 1 A candidate for election to the Democratic Party Central (2)2 Committee shall declare at the time of filing a certificate of candidacy which seat the 3 candidate is seeking. 4 A member elected to represent a specific county commissioner district who ceases to reside in that district may not continue to serve on the Central 5 6 Committee. 7 Any vacancy in a seat on the Central Committee held by an individual 8 elected from a county commissioner district shall be filled by an individual who resides in that district. 9 IN EACH COUNTY, THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC 10 PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL BE ELECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH: 11 12 **(I)** THE PARTY RULES OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY; 13 THE BYLAWS OF THE DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL (II)14 **COMMITTEE**; AND 15 (III) THE BYLAWS OF EACH COUNTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE. THE METHOD OF ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF EACH COUNTY 16 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL PROMOTE GEOGRAPHIC 17 BALANCE TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE. 18 19 NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR BEFORE THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY UNDER § 5-303(A) OF THIS ARTICLE, THE 20 21 DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE BOARD OF: 22 THE NUMBER OF ELECTED MEMBERS FOR EACH COUNTY (I)23DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE; AND 24 THE COMPOSITION OF THE DISTRICTS OF THE ELECTED (II)MEMBERS OF EACH COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE. 25 26 A CHANGE AFFECTING THE METHOD OF ELECTION OF COUNTY 27 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS MAY TAKE EFFECT ONLY 28 **AFTER:**
- 29 (I) AMPLE ADVANCE WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE CHANGE IS 30 PROVIDED TO THE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS;

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(II) A CHANGE HAS BEEN MADE IN THE BYLAWS OF THE COUNTY

- 1 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE; AND
- 2 (III) THE CHANGE IS APPROVED BY THE CHAIR OF THE 3 DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE.
- 4 (5) A CHANGE TO THE METHOD OF ELECTION OF COUNTY
 5 DEMOCRATIC PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS MAY NOT OCCUR DURING AN
 6 ELECTION CYCLE IF THE DEMOCRATIC STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAS MADE
 7 THE NOTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2020.
