2 **State Fire Marshal – Sprinkler Systems Enforcement**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Fire Marshal to enforce certain requirements
4 relating to fire sprinkler systems; and generally relating to the duties of the State
5 Fire Marshal.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Public Safety**

14 6–305.

15 (a) The State Fire Marshal shall enforce:

16 (1) all laws of the State that relate to:

17 (i) the prevention of fire;

1 (ii) the storage, sale, and use of explosives, combustibles, or other
2 dangerous articles, in solid, liquid, or gaseous form;

3 (iii) the installation and maintenance of all kinds of equipment
4 intended to control, detect, or extinguish fire;

5 (iv) the means and adequacy of exit, in case of fire, from buildings
6 and all other places in which individuals work, live, or congregate, except buildings that
7 are used solely as dwelling houses for no more than two families; and

8 (v) the suppression of arson; [and]

9 (2) the regulations adopted by the Commission under Subtitle 2 of this
10 title; AND

11 **(3) ANY REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE INSTALLATION OF**
12 **AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEMS IN NEW ONE- AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2020.
