BY adding to Article – Transportation Section 8-662 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 8-662. (A) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY POST INFORMATION ON SUICIDE PREVENTION, INCLUDING A HOTLINE NUMBER, ON ELECTRONIC SIGNS ALONG ANY
