- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 14 5–117.1.

15 (d) Subject to subsections (f) and (g) of this section, the Secretary shall issue a 16 handgun qualification license to a person who the Secretary finds:

- 17 (1) is at least 21 years old;
- 18 (2) is a resident of the State;

19 (3) except as provided in subsection (e) of this section, has demonstrated 20 satisfactory completion, within 3 years prior to the submission of the application, of a 21 firearms safety training course approved by the Secretary that includes:

(i) a minimum of 4 hours of instruction by a qualified handgun
