A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Environment - Solar Panel Stewardship Programs

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to develop certain guidelines for solar panel stewardship programs; requiring the Department to work with certain persons in the development of certain guidelines; requiring the Department to adopt certain guidelines in regulation on or before a certain date; prohibiting a certain manufacturer from selling or offering for sale in the State a solar panel unless the manufacturer has a certain solar panel stewardship plan and operates a certain solar panel stewardship program on or after a certain date; requiring a certain manufacturer to prepare and submit to the Department a certain solar panel stewardship plan on or before a certain date or within a certain number of days before completing a certain sale; establishing certain minimum requirements for a solar panel stewardship plan; prohibiting a manufacturer from charging a fee to a consumer for the takeback and recycling of an out-of-service solar panel; requiring the Department to review and approve certain solar panel stewardship plans under certain circumstances; authorizing a manufacturer to amend a certain solar panel stewardship plan under certain circumstances; authorizing a manufacturer to designate a stewardship organization to act as the manufacturer's agent for certain purposes; requiring a certain stewardship organization to provide certain information to the Department and to update the information at a certain time; requiring a manufacturer or the manufacturer's designated stewardship organization to make a certain report to the Department on or before certain dates and to post a copy of a certain report to a certain website; authorizing the Department to adopt certain regulations; establishing certain penalties for certain violations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to solar panel recycling and stewardship programs.

- 3 (2) "SOLAR PANEL" DOES NOT INCLUDE A BANK OF SOLAR CELLS

- 6 (E) "STEWARDSHIP ORGANIZATION" MEANS A PERSON THAT IS IN THE

- 10 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR SOLAR PANEL

- A PERSON THAT VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS PART OR A REGULATION 2 ADOPTED UNDER THIS PART IS SUBJECT TO:
- 3 (1) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A WARNING; AND
- 4 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, A CIVIL PENALTY 5 NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.
