A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City Public School System – School Named for Walter P. Carter**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners of the
4 Baltimore City Public School System to ensure that a public school in Baltimore City
5 is named exclusively for Walter P. Carter at all times without regard to certain
6 circumstances; and generally relating to public schools in Baltimore City.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Education**

20 4–301.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

22 (b) “Board” means the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners of the
23 Baltimore City Public School System.

2 (A) THE BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN BALTIMORE
3 CITY IS NAMED EXCLUSIVELY FOR WALTER P. CARTER AT ALL TIMES.

4 (B) THE BOARD SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENT OF THIS SECTION
5 WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY CLOSURE OR MERGER OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2020.
