4 FOR the purpose of, on or after a certain date, prohibiting the Department of the

Environment from approving coverage under a concentrated animal feeding operation (CAFO) Discharge permit for a certain CAFO, unless the permit applicant submits a certain manure transport plan to the Department as part of the permit application; requiring the Department to incorporate the terms of a certain manure transport plan into a certain CAFO Discharge permit for certain purposes; requiring the Department to suspend coverage of a certain CAFO under a certain CAFO

- Discharge permit under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to CAFO Discharge permits.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 2 (c) "CAFO" means a concentrated animal feeding operation, as defined in 3 Department regulations.
- 4 **9–326.1.**
- 5 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 6 INDICATED.
- 7 (2) "ORGANICS RECYCLING FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 8 § 9–1701 OF THIS TITLE.
- 9 (3) "PHOSPHORUS MANAGEMENT TOOL" MEANS THE MECHANISM,
 10 ADOPTED UNDER REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOR
 11 IDENTIFYING THE POTENTIAL RISK FOR PHOSPHORUS LOSS FROM FARMS.
- 12 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CAFO
 13 OR THE EXPANSION OF AN EXISTING CAFO IN A COUNTY WHERE MORE THAN 30%
 14 OF THE ACRES TESTED UNDER THE PHOSPHORUS MANAGEMENT TOOL HAVE A
 15 PHOSPHORUS FERTILITY INDEX VALUE OF 150 OR MORE.
- 16 (C) ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2021, THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT APPROVE
 17 COVERAGE UNDER A CAFO DISCHARGE PERMIT FOR A CAFO DESCRIBED IN
 18 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION UNLESS THE PERMIT APPLICANT SUBMITS TO THE
 19 DEPARTMENT, AS PART OF THE PERMIT APPLICATION, A PLAN TO TRANSPORT ALL
 20 OF THE MANURE PRODUCED BY THE CAFO:
- 21 (1) INTO A COUNTY WHERE LESS THAN 30% OF ACRES TESTED UNDER 22 THE PHOSPHORUS MANAGEMENT TOOL HAVE A PHOSPHORUS FERTILITY INDEX 23 VALUE OF 150 OR MORE; OR
- 24 (2) TO AN ORGANICS RECYCLING FACILITY.
- 25 (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:
- 26 (1) INCORPORATE THE TERMS OF A MANURE TRANSPORT PLAN SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION INTO THE CAFO DISCHARGE PERMIT FOR A CAFO DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION;
- 29 (2) MAKE COMPLIANCE WITH THE MANURE TRANSPORT PLAN A CONDITION OF COVERAGE UNDER THE CAFO DISCHARGE PERMIT; AND

- 1 (3) MONITOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MANURE TRANSPORT 2 PLAN TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE.
- 3 (E) IF THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF A CAFO FAILS TO TRANSPORT
 4 MANURE IN ACCORDANCE WITH A MANURE TRANSPORT PLAN SUBMITTED UNDER
 5 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUSPEND COVERAGE
 6 OF THE CAFO UNDER THE CAFO DISCHARGE PERMIT FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2020.
