- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14

- 17IN THIS SECTION, "RESIDENT CANADA GOOSE" MEANS A CANADA (A) 18 **GOOSE THAT:**
- 19(1) NESTS IN THE STATE DURING THE MONTHS OF MARCH, APRIL, 20MAY, OR JUNE; OR
- 21 (2) **RESIDES IN THE STATE DURING THE MONTHS OF JUNE, JULY, OR** 22AUGUST.

1 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE DEPARTMENT 2 MAY NOT AUTHORIZE A PERSON TO SHOOT RESIDENT CANADA GEESE IN CHARLES 3 COUNTY DURING LATE RESIDENT CANADA GOOSE SEASON UNLESS THE 4 DEPARTMENT EXTENDS THE SAME PRIVILEGES TO PERSONS IN ST. MARY'S 5 COUNTY.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 7 1, 2020.
