<p>The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) is a bi-county agency empowered by the State of Maryland in 1927 to acquire, develop, maintain, and administer a regional system of parks in Prince Georges and Montgomery Counties. Additionally, M-NCPPC is responsible for preparing and administering a General Plan for the physical development of most of the bi-county area and operating the public recreation programs in Prince Georges County.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Restoration of the Prince George's County World War I Memorial, known widely as the Peace Cross, is a high priority. The memorial is on the National Register of Historic Places, and its design is the work of master craftsman and contractor John J. Earley, developer of the Earley method of concrete construction. Funds will be used to develop architectural and engineering plans to prepare for restoration work.
