Renovating the Get Active room entails installing sprung floors and acoustic ceiling tiles, lighting, a sound system, mirrors, an A/V projector, seating and mechanized window treatments . These renovations will allow for better utilization of the space by increasing our capacity to facilitate performing arts enrichment for both youth who attend our programming and members of the greater community
