10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

On the National Register of Historic Places, Hosanna School, also known as Berkley School, was established in 1867 as the first public school for African Americans in Harford County. Built two years after the establishment of the Freedman's Bureau, which was designed to aid former enslaved blacks and poor whites in the wake of the Civil War. Hosanna is one of the few extant examples of the work of the Freedman's Bureau in Harford County and in the nation. It is a landmark showcasing the results of the Civil War, American Reconstruction Period, and the power and presence of education and community. Its mission is to collect, preserve and interpret the history of Harford County through the lens of African Americans. It features an interpretive components and the one room school experience on the first, programming/facility rental space on the second floor.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Handicap-friendly restroom restoration-the project would include the removal of deteriorating laminated walls; installation of water-resistance drywall;installation of wall tiles and floor tiles. Installation of ADA toilet, sink, grab bars, mirror and lights. Installation of new water-filter system to address the chronic mud-like water issues. Storage and Organization Built-ins: Design, construct, and install built-in cabinets that are multi-functioning to serve as desks, organizational spaces, and interpretive event space. The building is in desperate need for storage space. Permanent Interpretive Exhibition (life greater than 15 years): Construct and fabricate permanent exhibit components installed in a manner that dos not impact preservation of building, including vitrines and cases for objects, and didactic panels.
