The Grantee is the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County. LES has been named a National Blue Ribbon School and a Maryland Green School. The PTA averages approximately 200 members per year. On average, the PTA raises \$39,000 per year through annual membership dues, school events, and partnering with local businesses. Each year, the funds raised help further the students socially and academically.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

This year, one of the PTAs top priorities is to secure funds for a new electronic marquee sign for LES. LES believes the existing marquee sign that is located on the corner of Route 170 and School Lane was installed in 1973, the same year the building was last renovated. The purpose of the sign is to update the community on school events and to help direct travel around the community. The current sign does not have the capability to adequately meet its purpose. The sign is in disrepair and is missing letters. It is also small and does not have the space to convey complete messages to the community. It takes significant manpower to physically update the sign which takes staff away from daily responsibilities. An electronic sign will be visually appealing, thereby improving the image of LES and drawing the attention of those that pass by. It will also provide LES the ability to better convey information and to do so in an appropriate time-frame.
