10. Description and Purpose of Organiza					

Bishop Orlando Wilson is the pastor. I am the Vice President of the Early Learning Division of SEIU, Local 500 and each year, we participate or lead an outreach that supports programs for women, children or at risk youth. This year, we are taking on a more sizable request. New Antioch has an Outreach Center in the lower half of the church. Within that space, they execute many amazing, community based programs! In the quint area, they collect, weekly and distribute both perishable & non-perishable foods and clothing to the less fortunate; prepare food weekly to serve the less fortunate population under the Falls Road bridge; hold meeting for addiction and mentor fathers and sons to help them achieve self-sufficiency. These programs are the top priorities but not limited to those programs.

The ask is for the outreach center to be overhauled. It is dyer need of repairs. There was a flood there a few years ago; since then, they have been making do to serve the community with limited, functional space. However, the needs of the community consistently grows. The room needs electrical upgrading; dry wall needs to be replaced for the walls and ceiling; better lighting; the entrance, where they roll carts in and out to collect food from cars/trucks, is a small ramp that needs replacing (unstable). Updated office furniture (file cabinets, desk and chairs), clothing racks, and collection bins of some sort would help make the program run more efficiently for both patrons and volunteers.
