# <u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 300</u> (First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after "students" insert "<u>for a certain purpose</u>"; strike beginning with "and" in line 6 down through "purpose" in line 7; strike beginning with "providing" in line 7 down through "models;" in line 9 and substitute "<u>requiring an</u> <u>individualized education program team to notify certain parents or guardians that a</u> <u>learning continuity plan is in place within a certain number of days of a certain</u> <u>determination; requiring that the team seek input from a parent or guardian on how</u> <u>the learning continuity plan will best operate under a certain circumstance;</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 12 down through "date;" in line 13 and substitute "<u>providing that certain individualized education program teams may fulfill certain</u> <u>requirements in a certain manner by a certain date;</u>"; in line 13, after "defining" insert "<u>a</u>"; in the same line, strike "terms" and substitute "<u>term</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 20 through 24, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 28, strike the first "A" and substitute ":

### <u>(I)</u> <u>A</u>";

in line 30, strike "**IN PERSON OR**"; in the same line, after "**SCHOOL**" insert "<u>; AND</u>"; and strike beginning with "**BECAUSE**" in line 30 down through the semicolon in line 33.

On page 5, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 10, inclusive, and substitute:

# "(II) <u>THE SCHOOL IS PROVIDING INSTRUCTION IN SOME FORM</u> <u>TO ITS STUDENTS.</u>";

and in line 13, after "CONDITIONS" insert "<u>IN ORDER TO ENSURE THAT THE</u> <u>INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM IS PROCEEDING APPROPRIATELY</u> <u>DESPITE THE EMERGENCY CONDITIONS</u>".

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 5 through line 30 on page 6, inclusive.

On page 6, after line 30, insert:

"(3) (I) WITHIN 10 DAYS OF AN INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM TEAM DETERMINING THAT EMERGENCY CONDITIONS EXIST, THE TEAM SHALL MAKE A REASONABLE ATTEMPT TO NOTIFY THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A CHILD WHO REQUIRES AN INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM THAT A LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN IS IN PLACE.

# (II) IN CONTACTING A PARENT OR GUARDIAN UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH, THE INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM TEAM SHALL SEEK INPUT FROM THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN ON HOW THE LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN WILL BEST OPERATE DURING EMERGENCY CONDITIONS.";

and in line 31, strike "(7)" and substitute "(4)".

On page 7, in line 3, strike "(8)" and substitute "(5)".

On page 9, strike in their entirety lines 9 through 20, inclusive.

On page 9, after line 20, insert:

"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That an individualized education program team that had an individualized education program that was in

effect during the 2020–2021 school year may fulfill the requirements of Section 1 of this Act by taking the following actions on or before October 1, 2021:

(1) reviewing the successes and failures of the individualized education program during the 2020–2021 school year with the parent or guardian of the child requiring the individualized education program; and

(2) <u>amending the individualized education program based on the review</u> required in item (1) of this section.";

and in line 21, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
