in the same line, strike the first "SUSPECTED" and substitute "<u>ALLEGED</u>"; in the same line, strike "A SUSPECTED" and substitute "<u>AN ALLEGED</u>"; after line 8, insert:

# "(3) "COMPLAINT" MEANS A COMPLAINT REGARDING AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF ANY AIR OR WATER QUALITY REQUIREMENT IN THIS ARTICLE OR ANY AIR OR WATER QUALITY REGULATION AUTHORIZED BY A PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, INCLUDING FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS AND STANDARDS DELEGATED TO THE STATE.

in line 9, strike "**(B)**" and substitute "<u>(C)</u>"; in lines 10, 14, 17, 21, 23, and 26, in each instance, strike "SUSPECTED" and substitute "<u>ALLEGED</u>"; in line 13, after "SECTION" insert "<u>FOR 10 YEARS</u>"; and in line 28, strike "RECENTLY".

On page 3 of the bill, strike beginning with "**A**" in line 11 down through "**(2)**" in line 19.

On page 3 of the Environment and Transportation Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 3, strike beginning with "<u>AND</u>" in line 9 down through "<u>CLOSED</u>;" in line 11.

On page 4 of the bill, in lines 4, 6, 8, and 25, strike "(3)", "(2)", "(4)", and "(5)", respectively, and substitute "(2)", "(1)", "(3)", and "(4)", respectively.
