AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 494, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 8, after “sentence;” insert “requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to conduct a risk assessment before a hearing on a motion to reduce the duration of a sentence and requiring the results of the risk assessment to be admitted as evidence during the hearing on a motion to reduce the duration of a sentence;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the bill, after line 14, insert:

“(3) (I) BEFORE THE HEARING, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL CONDUCT A RISK ASSESSMENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO EVALUATE THE POTENTIAL THREAT POSED TO THE COMMUNITY BY THE INDIVIDUAL.

(II) THE RESULTS OF THE RISK ASSESSMENT SHALL BE ADMITTED AS EVIDENCE AT THE HEARING.”;

in lines 15 and 19, strike “(3)” and “(4)”, respectively, and substitute “(4)” and “(5)”, respectively.

On page 3, in line 27, strike “AND”; after line 27, insert:

“(11) THE RESULTS OF THE RISK ASSESSMENT CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES; AND”;

(Over)

and in line 28, strike “**(11)**” and substitute “**(12)**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1 of the Judicial Proceedings Committee Amendments (SB0494/308271/1), in lines 4 and 10 of Amendment No. 2, strike “**(5)**” and “**(6)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(6)**” and “**(7)**”, respectively.
