AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 135 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; after line 3, insert:

"<u>(Christopher King Access to Treatment Act)</u>";

and in line 21, after "Act;" insert "making this Act an emergency measure;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 4, strike "2022" and substitute "2021"; after line 6, insert:

"(I) FOR NOTIFYING A PATIENT ABOUT PAYMENT FOR SERVICES BEFORE THE PHARMACIST ADMINISTERS A MAINTENANCE INJECTABLE MEDICATION;";

and in lines 7, 10, and 13, strike "(I)", "(II)", and "(III)", respectively, and substitute "(II)", "(III)", and "(IV)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 18, strike the first "FOR" and substitute "<u>THAT PROVIDE</u>"; in line 25, after "PRACTITIONER," insert "<u>FOR PATIENT ASSESSMENT REGARDING</u> <u>AND</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 31 and 32 and substitute:

"<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.".
