AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; in the sponsor line, after "Systems)" insert "<u>and Senators Carozza, Gallion, Hester, Kagan, and Reilly</u>"; in line 4, after "schedule" insert "<u>or authorized for emergency use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration under a certain provision of federal law</u>"; in line 5, strike "certain entity or"; and in line 8, after "provisions;" insert "<u>making this Act an emergency</u> <u>measure; providing for the termination of this Act;</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 15, after "**PREVENTION**" insert "<u>OR AUTHORIZED FOR</u> <u>EMERGENCY USE BY THE U.S. FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION UNDER § 564</u> <u>OF THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 18, after "PROGRAM" insert "MEDICAL DIRECTOR".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 9 and 10 and substitute:

"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through July 1, 2024, and, at the end of July 1, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
