# <u>AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 489</u> (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after "consumed;" insert "<u>specifying that a license holder</u> <u>may serve a patron only a single serving of certain alcoholic beverages at a certain time;</u> <u>establishing a maximum number of servings of certain alcoholic beverages that may be</u> <u>provided to a patron per day;</u> <u>prohibiting a license holder from allowing a patron to</u> <u>remove alcohol purchased at the movie theater from the licensed premises;</u>"; and in line 12, after "fee;" insert "<u>providing that a holder of an alcoholic beverages license for a</u> <u>movie theater may renew the license only as a Class MT (movie theater) beer and wine</u> <u>license;</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 17, after "(E)" insert "(1)"; in the same line, after "LOBBY" insert "OR PUBLIC VIEWING THEATER"; in line 18, strike "AND MAY NOT BE CARRIED INTO PUBLIC VIEWING THEATERS"; and after line 18, insert:

"(2) <u>A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SERVE A PATRON ONLY A SINGLE</u> <u>SERVING OF BEER OR WINE AT A TIME, WITH A MAXIMUM OF TWO SERVINGS OF</u> <u>BEER OR WINE PER PATRON PER DAY.</u>

# (3) <u>THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW ALCOHOL PURCHASED</u> AT THE MOVIE THEATER TO BE REMOVED FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 23, insert:

"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the holder of an alcoholic beverages license for a movie theater in Anne Arundel County may renew the license

only as a Class MT (movie theater) beer and wine license under § 11–1006.2 of the Alcoholic Beverages Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.";
