AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 679

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after "consumed;" insert "specifying that a license holder may serve a patron only a single serving of certain alcoholic beverages at a certain time; establishing a maximum number of servings of certain alcoholic beverages that may be provided to a patron per day; prohibiting a license holder from allowing a patron to remove alcohol purchased at the movie theater from the licensed premises;"; and in line 12, after "fee;" insert "providing that a holder of an alcoholic beverages license for a movie theater may renew the license only as a Class MT (movie theater) beer and wine license;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 17, after "(E)" insert "(1)"; in the same line, after "LOBBY" insert "OR SCREENING AREA"; and after line 18, insert:

- "(2) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SERVE A PATRON ONLY A SINGLE SERVING OF BEER OR WINE AT A TIME, WITH A MAXIMUM OF TWO SERVINGS OF BEER OR WINE PER PATRON PER DAY.
- (3) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW ALCOHOL PURCHASED AT THE MOVIE THEATER TO BE REMOVED FROM THE LICENSED PREMISES.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 23, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the holder of an alcoholic beverages license for a movie theater may renew the license only as a Class MT (movie

theater) beer and wine license under § 11–1006.2 of the Alcoholic Beverages Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.";

and in line 24, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
