4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting public and nonpublic school employees from operating an electric retractable room partition in a school except under certain circumstances: 5 6 requiring any annual safety review, evaluation, or exercise for school employees in a 7 certain school building to include certain information and demonstrations; requiring 8 the State Department of Education to develop and disseminate model safety 9 guidelines on the safe operation of electric retractable room partitions; requiring the 10 Department to publish model safety guidelines on its public website; defining certain terms; requiring the State Department of Education to conduct a thorough review 11 and evaluation of certain matters relating to the operation of electric retractable 12 room partitions; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations or guidelines 13 on or before a certain date under certain circumstances; requiring the Department 14 15 to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date on its review and actions; and generally relating to electric retractable room partitions 16 17 and schools.

11 12 13 14	(b) On or before September 1, 2022, after conducting its thorough examination and review, the State Department of Education shall adopt any regulations or guidelines needed to ensure that the operation of electric retractable room partitions in public and nonpublic schools occur in the safest manner possible.
15 16 17	(c) On or before December 1, 2022, the State Department of Education shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on its review and any actions taken under this Act.
