BY adding to Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 14-417 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Finance and Procurement 14–417.

  10 CONDITIONS AT THE SITE ON WHICH THE PLANT SPECIES WILL BE PLANTED ARE TOO
  11 HARSH FOR A SIMILAR NATIVE PLANT SPECIES TO SURVIVE:
- 12 (H) THE PLANT SPECIES IS A PART OF A HISTORICALLY
  13 ACCURATE LANDSCAPING AROUND A STATE RECOGNIZED HISTORIC SITE;
- 14 (HI) (B) THE PROHIBITION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
  15 SECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE PLANT SPECIES IS COMMONLY USED FOR
  16 AGRICULTURAL OR HORTICULTURAL PURPOSES AND IS BEING MAINTAINED FOR
  17 THE PURPOSES OF EDUCATION OR RESEARCH; OR
- 18 (IV) THERE IS ANY OTHER GOOD CAUSE FOR WAIVING THE 19 PROHIBITION.
- 20 (2) THE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION FOR
  21 A GENERAL CATEGORY OF PROJECTS THAT ARE THE SAME OR SUBSTANTIALLY
  22 SIMILAR IN NATURE.
- 23 (3) THE BOARD MAY NOT GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
  24 TO PURCHASE OR PLANT A "TIER 1 INVASIVE PLANT" OR "TIER 2 INVASIVE PLANT",
  25 AS CLASSIFIED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE
  26 IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 9.5, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE AGRICULTURE ARTICLE.
- 27 (C) THE BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF 28 AGRICULTURE, SHALL:
- 29 (1) MAINTAIN A LIST OF NATIVE PLANT SPECIES THAT IS THE SAME OR
  30 SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE MOST RECENT PUBLICATION OF THE U.S. FISH
  31 AND WILDLIFE SERVICE'S NATIVE PLANTS FOR WILDLIFE HABITAT AND
  32 CONSERVATION LANDSCAPING FOR THE CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED: AND
