Jones Alzheimer's Disease and Related $\mathbf{5}$ 6 Disorders Council, and the Greater Maryland Chapter of the Alzheimer's 7 Association, to incorporate certain information regarding cognitive impairment, 8 Alzheimer's disease, and other types of dementia into relevant public health outreach programs administered by the Maryland Department of Health; and 9 10 generally relating to public health outreach programs administered by the Maryland 11 Department of Health.
