- 5 (a) Prior to the transfer date:
- 6 (1) The Board of Public Works shall approve the articles of incorporation of 7 the Medical System Corporation which shall reflect the requirements of this subtitle; and
 - (2) The Board of Regents and the Board of Directors shall take all actions necessary to create and organize the Medical System Corporation, which shall be organized for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes and shall attain and maintain exemption from federal income taxation but which shall not be a State agency, political subdivision, public body, public corporation, or municipal corporation and, EXCEPT FOR THE PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT AND OPEN MEETINGS ACT, is not subject to any provisions of law affecting only governmental or public entities.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
