## A BILL ENTITLED

2 Vehicle Laws - Failure to Pay Video Toll - Outstanding Fines

- 3 FOR the purpose of reducing the penalty for certain outstanding civil citations for video toll
- 4 violations; and generally relating to civil penalties for toll violations.
- 5 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article – Transportation

- 18 21–1414.
- 19 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 20 (4) "Notice of toll due" or "notice" means an administrative notice of a video
- 21 toll transaction.

- 1 (9) "Toll violation" means the failure to pay a video toll within the time 2 prescribed by the Authority in a notice of toll due.
- 3 (10) "Video monitoring system" means a device installed to work in 4 conjunction with a toll collection facility that produces a recorded image when a video toll 5 transaction occurs.
- 6 (11) "Video toll" means the amount assessed by the Authority when a video toll transaction occurs.
- 8 (12) "Video toll transaction" means any transaction in which a motor vehicle 9 does not or did not pay a toll at the time of passage through a toll collection facility with a 10 video monitoring system.
- 11 (c) (1) Failure of the person alleged to be liable to pay the video toll under a 12 notice of toll due by the date stated on the notice shall constitute a toll violation subject to 13 a civil citation and a civil penalty, which shall be assessed 15 days after the toll violation 14 occurs, as provided for in the regulations of the Authority.
- 15 (2) A registered owner of a motor vehicle shall not be liable for a civil penalty imposed under this section if the operator of the motor vehicle has been convicted of failure or refusal to pay a toll under § 21–1413 of this subtitle for the same violation.
- 18 (3) THE PENALTY FOR EACH OUTSTANDING CIVIL CITATION 19 ASSESSED ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2021, SHALL BE REDUCED TO \$25.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
