3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to establish a model policy 4 to support the educational and parenting goals and improve the educational $\mathbf{5}$ outcomes of pregnant and parenting students; requiring the model policy to include 6 certain policies and procedures; requiring each county board of education to establish 7a certain policy based on the Department's model policy; providing for the 8 construction of certain provisions of this Act; altering the required contents of a 9 certain attendance policy developed by a county board; defining a certain term; and 10 generally relating to pregnant and parenting students.

3 (iii) Excuse any parenting-related absences due to an illness or a 4 medical appointment of the student's child, including up to 4 days of absences per school 5 year for which the school may not require a note from a physician; [and]

6 (iv) Excuse any absence due to a legal appointment involving the 7 pregnant or parenting student that is related to family law proceedings, including adoption, 8 custody, and visitation; AND

9 (V) EXCUSE ANY PARENTING-RELATED ABSENCE FROM A 10 CLASS DUE TO USE OF A LACTATION SPACE TO NURSE OR EXPRESS BREAST MILK.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2021.
