# Health Care Facilities – Assisted Living Programs – Memory Care and Alzheimer's Disease Unit Regulations

FOR the purpose of requiring that the Maryland Department of Health adopt certain
regulations that establish specific standards governing memory care and
Alzheimer's disease units in assisted living programs, including certain training
requirements, certain staffing pattern requirements, certain activity requirements,
certain admissions and discharge criteria, and certain other procedures, and that
require compliance by assisted living programs with the standards; defining certain
terms; and generally relating to assisted living programs.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2021.
