BY adding to Article - Education Section 7–424.4 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education

- 1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "SYMBOL OF HATE" MEANS A SYMBOL, AN 2 IMAGE, OR AN OBJECT THAT EXPRESSES ANIMUS TOWARD ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL ON
- 3 THE BASIS OF RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, GENDER IDENTITY, SEXUAL ORIENTATION,
- 4 DISABILITY, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN THAT MAY BE REASONABLY FORECAST TO CAUSE
- 5 A DISRUPTION.
- 6 (2) "SYMBOL OF HATE" <u>INCLUDES MAY INCLUDE</u>, <u>SUBJECT TO A</u>
  7 REASONABLE FORECAST OF DISRUPTION, A NOOSE, SWASTIKA, AND CONFEDERATE
- 8 FLAG.
- 9 (B) (1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 10 SUBSECTION, ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2021, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL

- 22 (C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND DISTRIBUTE EDUCATIONAL
- 23 MATERIALS DETAILING THE POLICY ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION, INCLUDING
- 24 CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATIONS, TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL UNDER ITS
- 25 JURISDICTION FOR DISSEMINATION TO ALL SCHOOL EMPLOYEES AND STUDENTS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
