$\mathbf{2}$ Natural Resources - Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Certificates - Digital 3 or Electronic Format and Stamps – Revisions

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to make available and, on request, issue certain licenses, permits, registrations, and certificates and stamps $\mathbf{5}$ 6 in a digital or electronic format; establishing that an individual may satisfy certain 7 requirements to possess or display a license, permit, registration, or certificate or 8 stamp by possessing or displaying the document in a certain digital or electronic 9 format subject to a certain exception; requiring a certain license to be permanently affixed to a boat; requiring the Department to design certain digital or electronic 10 documents in a certain manner prohibiting certain applicants from willfully making 11 12a certain false statement or representation; repealing certain provisions of law requiring certain licensees to sign a license in a certain manner at a certain time; 13 14making a stylistic change; and generally relating to licenses, permits, registrations, 15and certificates and stamps issued by the Department of Natural Resources.
