# **Electric Cooperatives – Meetings – Alterations**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing an electric cooperative to hold certain meetings virtually or with a combination of in-person and virtual attendance; requiring the members 4  $\mathbf{5}$ of the cooperative, by majority vote, to determine in the cooperative's bylaws how 6 meetings may be held; requiring the notice for a meeting that will be held virtually 7 or with a combination of in-person and virtual attendance to include certain 8 information; altering the requirements for a quorum to include members attending 9 the meeting rather than members present in person; repealing the requirement that 10 for voting to occur in a certain manner the manner must be provided in an electric 11 cooperative's bylaws; authorizing voting in any manner provided in an electric 12 cooperative's bylaws; making stylistic and conforming changes; and generally 13relating to meetings of members of electric cooperatives.

(a) Each member of a cooperative is entitled to one vote on each matter submittedto a vote at a meeting of the members.
