- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Public Safety
- 14 5-141.

15 (a) A dealer or other person may not be a knowing participant in a straw purchase 16 of a regulated firearm to a minor or to a person prohibited by law from possessing a 17 regulated firearm.

18 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a [misdemeanor] FELONY and 19 on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 years or a fine not exceeding 20 \$25,000 or both.

21 (c) Each violation of this section is a separate crime.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2021.
