- FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Dental Examiners to dispose of certain disciplinary matters within a certain period of time after a certain hearing; authorizing a certain licensee to provide certain written notice that a decision is due; establishing that a certain decision shall be construed in a certain manner under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to issue a certain order on a certain summary suspension within a certain period of time; and generally relating to dispositions and summary suspensions and the State Board of Dental Examiners.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) UNLESS OTHERWISE PRECLUDED BY LAW, THE BOARD SHALL DISPOSE 21 OF A MATTER REGARDING THE DISCIPLINE OF A LICENSEE WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER 22 THE DATE OF ANY HEARING HELD UNDER § 4–318 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 23 (B) (1) IF THE BOARD DOES NOT DISPOSE OF A MATTER REGARDING THE 24 DISCIPLINE OF A LICENSEE WITHIN THE TIME REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF



- 1 THIS SECTION, THE LICENSEE MAY PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE BOARD THAT

- 3 (2) IF THE BOARD DOES NOT DISPOSE OF A MATTER REGARDING THE
- 4 DISCIPLINE OF A LICENSEE WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF A NOTICE PROVIDED
- 5 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DECISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO

- 7 (C) IF THE BOARD SUMMARILY SUSPENDS A LICENSE UNDER § 10–226 OF

- 9 APPEALABLE ORDER ON THE SUMMARY SUSPENSION WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE
