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States of Emergency and Catastrophic Health Emergencies – Renewals – Authorization by General Assembly or Legislative Policy Committee

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Governor from renewing a state of emergency or 5 catastrophic health emergency for more than a certain period of time without 6 approval from the General Assembly by joint resolution or, under certain 7 circumstances, by a majority vote of the Legislative Policy Committee; authorizing 8 the Committee to vote on certain requests at a meeting held either in person or 9 virtually; clarifying that a state of emergency expires under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the renewal of states of emergency and catastrophic health 10 11 emergencies.
