15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 20	(A) A LANDLORD MAY NOT USE A LEASE OR FORM OF LEASE CONTAINING OR REQUIRE AS A PROVISION OF A LEASE THAT A TENANT AGREE TO SIGN:
21	(1) AN ESTOPPEL CERTIFICATE; OR
22 23	(2) A SUBORDINATION, NON-DISTURBANCE, AND ATTORNMENT AGREEMENT.



- 1 (B) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED AS PROHIBITING A
  2 LANDLORD FROM REQUESTING THAT A TENANT AGREE TO SIGN AN ESTOPPEL
  3 CERTIFICATE OR A SUBORDINATION, NON-DISTURBANCE, AND ATTORNMENT
  4 AGREEMENT SEPARATELY FROM A LEASE AGREEMENT.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing obligation 6 or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2021.
