[(2)] (II) the disclosure is required by federal or State law; OR

2 (2) WEAR A PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION TAG OR BADGE THAT 3 INDICATES THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S FIRST OR LAST NAME WHEN THE 4 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS ON DUTY OR ACTING IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY AS 5 A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2021.
