Attorney General - Climate Change Actions - Authorization

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Attorney General to take certain actions to hold certain entities accountable for certain conduct that has contributed to climate change; authorizing the Attorney General to hire outside counsel on a certain basis to assist with certain actions if the Attorney General makes a certain determination; stating the intent of the General Assembly; and generally relating to the authority of the Attorney General.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE STATE'S
- 19 CITIZENS AND ENVIRONMENT, IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT
- 20 BUSINESSES, CORPORATIONS, AND OTHER SIMILAR ENTITIES WHOSE TORTIOUS OR
- 21 OTHERWISE UNLAWFUL CONDUCT HAS CONTRIBUTED TO CLIMATE CHANGE BE
- 22 HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR THE ASSOCIATED ENVIRONMENTAL AND OTHER HARMS
- 23 CAUSED, WHETHER THROUGH FRAUD, DECEPTION, OR ANY OTHER MECHANISM,
- 24 ACTION, INACTION, OR PRACTICE.

- 1 (B) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY INVESTIGATE, COMMENCE, AND PROSECUTE OR DEFEND ANY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL SUIT OR ACTION THAT HOLDS ACCOUNTABLE A BUSINESS, CORPORATION, OR OTHER SIMILAR ENTITY WHOSE TORTIOUS OR OTHERWISE UNLAWFUL CONDUCT HAS CONTRIBUTED TO CLIMATE CHANGE THROUGH FRAUD, DECEPTION, OR ANY OTHER MECHANISM, ACTION, INACTION, OR PRACTICE.
- 7 (C) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY HIRE OUTSIDE COUNSEL ON A 8 CONTINGENCY FEE BASIS TO ASSIST WITH AN ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE 9 ATTORNEY GENERAL DETERMINES THAT HIRING OUTSIDE COUNSEL ON SUCH A 10 BASIS IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE STATE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
