A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Supplemental Rebate Program – Subscription Model for Hepatitis C Therapies

4 FOR the purpose of requiring, on or before a certain date, the Maryland Department of $\mathbf{5}$ Health to apply to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for a State plan 6 amendment that authorizes certain supplemental rebate agreements and seeks an 7 approval that authorizes a certain subscription model; requiring, to the extent 8 possible, the Maryland Department of Health, in collaboration with the Department 9 of Public Safety and Correctional Services and other relevant State agencies, to develop a certain subscription model that covers certain individuals in a certain 10 11 manner; and generally relating to a State plan amendment and supplemental rebate 12agreements.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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22 (A) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2021, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL APPLY TO 23 THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES FOR A STATE PLAN 24 AMENDMENT THAT:

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1 (1) AUTHORIZES THE STATE TO ENTER INTO VALUE-BASED 2 ARRANGEMENTS WITH DRUG MANUFACTURERS THROUGH SUPPLEMENTAL REBATE 3 AGREEMENTS; AND

4 (2) SEEKS AN APPROVAL THAT AUTHORIZES A SUBSCRIPTION MODEL $\mathbf{5}$ FOR HEPATITIS C THERAPIES REGARDLESS OF DISEASE SEVERITY OR FIBROSIS 6 LEVEL. DETERMINED BY METAVIR SCORE OR AN AS ALTERNATIVE NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED DIAGNOSTIC OR PROGNOSTIC ASSESSMENT TOOL. 7

8 (B) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE DEPARTMENT, IN COORDINATION 9 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES AND 10 ANY OTHER RELEVANT STATE AGENCY, SHALL DEVELOP A SUBSCRIPTION MODEL 11 FOR HEPATITIS C THERAPIES THAT COVERS ALL ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS SERVED BY 12 A STATE PROGRAM WHILE PRESERVING THE ABILITY TO MAXIMIZE THE USE OF 13 FEDERAL FUNDS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June1, 2021.
