SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 – Calvert County

15 6–103.

16 (a) When it is advantageous to the county to do so, the county may contract to 17 purchase supplies or services for periods of more than one year if:

18 (1) Funds for the total cost of the contract are available at the time the 19 contract is executed; or

1 (2) Subject to Subsection (c) of this section, a contract requiring the 2 payment of funds from appropriations of more than one fiscal year is approved by resolution 3 of the Commissioners.

4 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) of this section, the County may enter into a 5 contract for solid waste disposal that:

(1) May include transportation;

7 (2) May require payment of funds from appropriations of the County or 8 receipt of payment to the County; and

9

(3) Is not for more than a twenty–year initial term.

10 (c) A contract requiring the payment of funds from appropriations of more than 11 one fiscal year, approved by resolution of the Commissioners, shall be awarded as a 12 one-year contract with the option to renew for:

- 13 (1) Not more than four one–year terms; or
- 14 (2) Not more than 19 one–year terms if the contract is for:
- 15 (i) Banking and investment services;
- 16 (ii) Retirement and pension system management;
- 17 (iii) Health insurance; or
- 18 (iv) Software.

19 (D) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY 20 MAY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR A CELLULAR TOWER LEASE, INCLUDING A 21 CELLULAR TOWER LEASE ON A WATER TOWER, IF THE INITIAL TERM OF THE LEASE 22 IS NOT MORE THAN **20** YEARS.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2021.
