1 AN ACT concerning

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Economic Development – Maryland Innovation Initiative University Expansion Pilot Program – Establishment

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Innovation Initiative University Expansion 5 Pilot Program within the Maryland Technology Development Corporation; providing 6 for the purpose of the Pilot Program; requiring the Maryland Innovation Initiative 7 within the Corporation to implement and administer the Pilot Program; authorizing 8 Frostburg State University to participate in the Pilot Program; requiring Frostburg 9 State University to pay a certain annual contribution to participate in the Pilot 10 Program; establishing eligibility criteria for project proposals to receive funding 11 under the Pilot Program; requiring the Initiative to develop certain criteria to 12 review, evaluate, and rate certain project proposals; requiring the Executive Director 13 of the Initiative to distribute certain grants in a certain manner; requiring the Governor to include a certain amount in the State budget for certain fiscal years for 14 15 the Pilot Program; requiring the Corporation to make a certain report on or before a 16 certain date; altering the purpose and contents of the Maryland Innovation Initiative 17 Fund; defining a certain term; providing for the termination of this Act; and 18 generally relating to the establishment of the Maryland Innovation Initiative 19 University Expansion Pilot Program.

- 3 (F) (1) THE INITIATIVE SHALL DEVELOP CRITERIA TO REVIEW, 4 EVALUATE, AND RATE PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PILOT 5 PROGRAM.
- 6 (2) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL DISTRIBUTE GRANTS TO PROJECTS BASED ON THE CRITERIA DEVELOPED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 8 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 9 (G) (1) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 AND 2024, EACH YEAR THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$500,000 FOR THE PILOT PROGRAM.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
