17 IF A LANDLORD NOTIFIES A TENANT BY E-MAIL ABOUT THE CANCELLATION 18 OR RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING LEASE, THE LANDLORD SHALL ALSO NOTIFY THE 19 TENANT BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER THE DATE ON WHICH THE 20 ORIGINAL E-MAIL WAS SENT.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2021.
